

Establishment of the Judicial Studies Committee.	<p>1. There shall be a Judicial Studies Committee, hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”, which shall act under the general direction of the Chief Justice.</p>
Objectives of the Judicial Studies Committee.	<p>2. The Committee shall have the following objectives:-</p> <p>(a) to identify the training needs of members of the judiciary;</p> <p>(b) to organise induction courses for new members of the judiciary;</p> <p>(c) to provide training for members of the judiciary;</p> <p>(d) to organise lectures, seminars, courses and similar events for members of the judiciary;</p> <p>(e) to inform members of the judiciary of recent legal developments through the use of information technology;</p> <p>(f) to issue updated papers on aspects of judicial work; and</p> <p>(g) to promote international co-operation in matters touching upon judicial training.</p>
Appointment of the Judicial Studies Committee.	<p>3. (1) The Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Committee shall be appointed by the Chief Justice and shall be selected from amongst the members of the judiciary, either serving or retired.</p> <p>(2) The Chairman of the Committee shall have both an original vote and a casting vote.</p> <p>(3) The Minister responsible for justice shall appoint two members to sit on the Committee.</p> <p>(4) One of the members appointed on the Committee by the Minister responsible for justice shall act as Secretary to the Committee.</p> <p>(5) The appointments mentioned in sub-articles (1), (3) and (4) of this article shall be for a period of three years and may be renewed for further three-year periods.</p>
Finances of the Judicial Studies Committee.	<p>4. (1) The Committee shall forward annual financial plans to the Director, Finance and Administration, falling within the Courts of Justice Division, who shall thereupon request the appropriate authorities to allocate funds for the purpose of the proper working of the Committee.</p> <p>(2) The Director, Finance and Administration, falling within the Courts of Justice Division, shall administer the funds allocated to</p>

	<p>the Committee as the Committee may direct.</p> <p>(3) The Courts of Justice Division shall provide the necessary support service to the Committee in order to enable it to carry out the objectives listed in article 2, above.</p>
